Tony Juniper is a campaigner, writer, sustainability adviser and a well-known British environmentalist. He currently works as a special adviser to the Prince of Wales Charities' International Sustainability Unit and has spent the last 25 years working for change toward a more sustainable society at local, national and international levels.

His most recent book *What has Nature ever done for us?* was published in January 2013 and is now a best-seller. The title won a gold medal in the US Independent Publishers' 2013 Living Now Book Awards.

Tony will be speaking in College on Friday 7 March in the Queen's Building at 5.30pm. The talk will be followed by a buffet supper in the Old Library.

Enter a world of beauty and watch as Ann Witheridge, co-founder of the Studios and former Cambridge graduate, captures the model on canvas. You will have the chance to ask questions as the process unfurls and Ann will talk her audience through the key points of interest.
