BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Emmanuel is one of the Colleges that make up the collegiate structure of the University of Cambridge. We provide a community-focused environment for learning, living and working in peaceful and beautiful grounds situated in the centre of the City. The College was founded in 1584 by Sir Walter Mildmay and has been a centre of outstanding learning ever since. It currently has over 650 students (undergraduate and postgraduate), nearly 100 Fellows (who teach and research at the College) and over 150 staff. We welcome people into the Emma community from across the globe, of many different backgrounds, with many different experiences.

The Household Department is responsible for the general cleaning across the entire College site including offsite accommodation. The role of the bedmaker is responsible for cleaning a variety of areas across the College including student and fellow's accommodation, study areas, guest houses and offices.

The College is seeking friendly, flexible and reliable individuals to join the Housekeeping team providing a high standard of cleaning services across the College.

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITES

Carry out the routine cleaning of allocated areas of the College, to include:

- Cleaning of bathroom facilities
- Cleaning of kitchen areas including GIP rooms
- Cleaning of corridors and staircases
- Cleaning of guest and student accommodation
- The changing of bed linen is required for guest accommodation and during conference periods only
- Occasional weekend working is required during graduation
- Some weekend working is available for guest rooms and occasional conferences

Start time between 7.45am and 9am each morning, Monday to Friday
