FOR STUDENTS THAT COME TO STUDY AT CAMBRIDGE FROM OUTSIDE THE UK AND REQUIRE A UK VISA:

BRP collection

Your actual visa, in the form of a Biometric Residence Permit (BRP), will need to be collected on arrival in the UK. Your BRP is the documentary evidence of your UK immigration permission. You will need to collect your BRP either from the University or the Post Office in Cambridge.
