MASt students, overseas Clinical Medical students, and some others (details upon request) - these are liable to an additional COLLEGE FEE of £9,400

MAINTENANCE - Personal Charges (these charges are the personal responsibility of the Postgraduate)

The minimum amount recommended by the University for Maintenance is £14,850 for a year (£12,434 for a 9 month course)
