

Cambridge GP Surgeries

All students living in Cambridge are **strongly advised** to register with a local GP practice on arrival, rather than waiting to feel unwell. This is particularly important if you have a medical condition which requires ongoing treatment. Although students are not permitted to register with both a Cambridge GP and one at home, you can register in Cambridge in term time and see your home GP during vacations by completing a temporary resident form (available from GP surgeries).

PLEASE NOTE: Students already registered in the UK will need to know their NHS number. EU and Overseas Students may be required to show their passports/visas and possibly their offer letter from the College. **We advise you to telephone a practice before you go (8.30am for same day appointment) to check their requirements or check their website for registration information.**
