Hello! We'd like to wish you a warm welcome from ECSU, the Emmanuel College Students Union.

We hope you're all very excited to be part of the college community, and we can't wait to see you all here in October! To make sure that everything goes as smoothly as possible when moving in, we've put together this card which should help you navigate moving into college on day one.

**If you're moving into OLD SOUTH COURT (Staircases L, L2, M, M2, U and V):**

Drive down Regent's Street, turning right after the University Arms Hotel into Park Terrace. The College can be accessed via the second left into Camden Court (marked 'Private Road', and Emmanuel students will be holding up signs).

You will be directed to park in the student drop-off by the Library, and Old South Court will be right in front of you.

When exiting the drop-off area, follow the one-way system in the College out to the Dean's Gate by Camden House, and take a left turn down Park Terrace.

**If you're moving into NEW SOUTH COURT (M3, M4):**

The same process as for Old South (above): drive down Regent's Street, turning right after the University Arms Hotel, into Park Terrace.

Take the the second left into Camden Court (marked 'Private Road', and Emmanuel students will be holding up signs). You will be directed to park in the student drop-off by the Library, and New South Court is behind Old South Court, built in a similar style but slightly newer.

When exiting the drop-off area, follow the one-way system in the College out to the Dean's Gate by Camden House, and take a left turn down Park Terrace.

**If you're moving into NORTH COURT (staircases Q, R, Y, Z and Cloisters):**

Drive down Parker Street, and continue over the mini roundabout into Emmanuel Street (marked 'access only'). The entrance to North Court is on the right after the left-hand bend in the road (Emma students will be holding up signs). Drive through the gates to North Court and head around the sunken garden to your staircase. When leaving, complete the lap of the sunken garden and head out onto Emmanuel Street, turning right to follow the one-way system onto St Andrews Street.

**A FEW COMMON QUESTIONS**

**The one-way system?**

Cambridge city centre operates with a one-way system for vehicles on some of the roads in order to prevent congestion. In this case, it only applies to Drummer Street, Emmanuel Street, and Park Terrace.

Missing entrances is no problem however, as if you drive past the entrance to North Court, the one-way system will loop you back around in no time at all.

**Is there anywhere I can park?**

Moving in can be a very busy time, and the College site is not particularly suited for many parked cars.

For this reason, if you feel like staying for longer than the time it takes to move in, it is better to find some parking elsewhere in the city centre.

The Grand Arcade car park is across the road from Emmanuel, and can be accessed via Regent's Street, and the roads around Downing College & the University's Downing Site. Queen Anne Terrace car park is directly opposite the Camden Court entrance across Parker's Piece; you can turn right from Park Terrace, and enter the car park from Gonville Place. Alternatively, turning left from Parkside and further down East Road are the Grafton Centre car parks.

**Who can I get in touch with if I get lost or can't find where I'm going?**

The team in the Porters' Lodge are available 24/7, and can be called on 01223 334200. All the relevant gates to the freshers' accommodation will be open, and Emmanuel students will be holding signs to direct you to the correct place to go.
