We are delighted to welcome Christina Lambert (1982), Lead Counsel to the Hillsborough Inquests and Henrietta Hill (1991), Counsel for the 22 families, to give a talk reflecting on the inquests between 2014 and 2016, at 5.30pm in the Queen's Building Lecture Theatre.

Christina and Henrietta will be talking about why fresh inquests were ordered in 2014, their differing roles in the inquests, the practical and legal challenges which the inquests presented, and the solutions and the wider perspective: concurrent investigations and possible future legal action.

**Emmanuel Society visit to Hillsborough Castle, near Belfast – Saturday 29 October**

The Society has arranged a visit to Hillsborough Castle near Belfast on Saturday 29 October. The late Georgian mansion was built in the 1770s by Wills Hill, first Marquis of Downshire and was later remodelled in the 19th and early 20th centuries. Today, it is a working royal palace functioning as the official residence of the Royal Family when they are in Northern Ireland, and

it has been the home of the Secretary of State since the 1970s.

We will meet at 10.30am for morning coffee in the castle, with a guided tour of the state rooms, including the majestic Throne Room and graceful Drawing Room, at 11.15am. Lunch (soup and sandwiches) will be served at The Plough Inn by the castle entrance. Afterwards, Members are welcome to return to wander through 98 acres of beautiful gardens developed from the 1760s onwards, which offer a contrast of ornamental grounds, peaceful woodland, meandering waterways, and trimmed lawns. Features include a statue of Ossian outside the main entrance, the Lady Alice Temple, a Quaker burial ground and an ice house.
