Congratulations

The College would like to congratulate the Master-Elect, Dame Fiona Reynolds, on her election to an Honorary Fellowship of the British Academy. It also congratulates Fellows Dr Larry King (2006) and Dr Mark Gales (2004), who have been promoted to Professorships, Dr Frank Jiggins (1993) and Dr Julian Hibberd (2000), who have been promoted to Readerships, and Dr Okeoghene Odudu (2006) and Dr Jonathan Simons (2008), who have been promoted to Senior Lectureships. Congratulations are also in order for Professor Geoffrey Smith (2011), who has won the 2012 GlaxoSmithKline International Member of the Year award.

Professor Florin Udrea (1998) has won a Royal Academy of Engineering Silver Medal award for his outstanding commercial success. Florin received his medal at the Academy's annual awards dinner at London's Royal Opera House on 26 June.
