Access News

Our Schools' Liaison Officer has been very busy since the start of Michaelmas term, and the College has played host to more than 170 school students in September and October.

On 27 and 28 September, the College held its first Law School residential course, to give sixth-form students a taste of what it is like to study law at the University. Twenty-four students attended lectures and seminars on topics such as constitutional law, and grappled with questions on Article 50 and 'Brexit'.

Ten students from our 'Link Areas' of Essex and Sheffield also attended the annual ECSU Shadowing Scheme,

attending lectures, supervisions and even a Formal Hall with current undergraduates.

Anita Magee, our Schools' Liaison Officer, has also been working in our 'Link Areas', visiting over 250 students across seven schools in Sheffield, attending Opportunity Thurrock, and the Colchester Careers Fair in Essex.
